provider received educational materials describing the importance and benefits of dental
care. The provider also received toothbrushes, toothpaste, and dental floss for each child,
parent education materials about oral health, a book about visiting the dentist, a timer, and a
packet of activities to do with children. Parents were welcomed at the visits, and providers
were encouraged to share the information with their families, as that is where the real
change takes place.

The goal of the program is that some ofthe providers would implement tooth brushing into
their routines so children could brush each day at childcare. Another goal was that children
would learn the importance of daily brushing, that parents would recognize the importance of
brushing and other dental care. Another goal is that through the story, the children would
