

After 58 years of marriage, Elroy—known as Burgie to many—and Nita Burgeson of Granite Falls have a sense of comfortable compatibility. Hearing them reminisce about careers, raising their two children and spending time with four grandchildren, you wouldn't know how big of a role they played in helping revive southwest Minnesota.

The couple met at Mankato State University. After a few years of Elroy teaching in Butterfield, they moved into the Granite Falls home they still own today. At the time, it was on the edge of town, a setting Nita enjoyed since it reminded her of growing up on a farm. Now, it's surrounded by more homes and sits just blocks from a place where Elroy spent much of his time.

For many years, Elroy served as an administrator for the Granite Falls Area Vocational Technical Institute, which was one of 33 like it in the state. He built its programs from the ground up, and even in retirement, education remains his passion.

Elroy recalls a phone call from then-President of Southwest Minnesota State University Robert Carothers in the mid-1980s. The McKnight Foundation wanted to help rural Minnesota as it faced economic and social crisis. Together with Mark Loftus, also then with the University, they submitted the first proposal

to McKnight to create the Southwest Minnesota Initiative Fund-later renamed Southwest Initiative Foundation—to help struggling communities, nonprofits, businesses and families.

"What amazes me is we were a part of something that turned out to be so important for southwest Minnesota," Elroy said, referencing that SWIF has distributed over \$54 million through grants and loans, saved or created hundreds of jobs, and improved the quality of life in the region. "From a humble beginning, it grew to something beyond our imagination. I often wonder what southwest Minnesota would be like today without the existence of SWIF."

Besides serving on SWIF's Board of Directors, Elroy chuckles as he recalls being president of almost everything in town. He also served on the city council and as mayor. Nita made time while raising children to work in retail and real estate while being active in the Jaycees, church and Cub Scouts.

"We try to give back—not that we're rich," Elroy said. "I just don't think that's an excuse not to give. I know it's important. We should try to help if we can."

Elroy and Nita have been faithful donors to SWIF's General Endowment, which supports work throughout the region. After the Granite Falls Area Community Foundation, one of SWIF's 22 community foundation partners, formed in 2009, they supported their local endowment as well.

Both seem to agree they've lived by a 'get involved, give a little' attitude. Community aside, they fondly remember family trips to the Black Hills, Yellowstone National Park, visits to a brother in California and time spent fishing in the river, all of which make them seem so much like other southwest Minnesota families.

While they remain humble—minus Nita claiming her husband can laugh harder than anyone—we know this family's generous leadership and contributions have made a lasting impact.

# The Schwan Food Company: Beyond Corporate Giving

Just like their familiar yellow trucks seen throughout southwest Minnesota, *The Schwan Food Company's* many contributions to Southwest Initiative Foundation (SWIF) are a vivid reminder of this business's legacy of giving in the region and beyond.

The Schwan Food Company is usually best known for its very first product—ice cream. In 1952, founder Marvin Schwan (pictured left) packed 14 gallons of his

family's ice cream into a van and started visiting customers in rural southwest Minnesota. By the end of the day, it was all sold and the home delivery business model that would grow his company into a frozen-food industry leader was born.

Since then, home delivery, retail grocery and food service have transformed this company from local to national, with more than 16,000 employees. But corporate headquarters remain in Minnesota—Marshall and Bloomington—as does an enduring commitment to this region.

The company's legacy of giving through SWIF began in 1990, when Marvin and The Schwan Food Company made a generous gift to honor his parents. The Paul and Alma Schwan Aging Trust Endowment Fund was created to help communities prepare for and respond to the opportunities and challenges of an aging rural society. Other organizations and individuals have continued giving to the fund, creating a strong, permanent resource for southwest Minnesota.





Some of the fund's greatest impact was made by supporting SWIF's Parish Nurse Program and training parish nurses who have served more than 100 southwest Minnesota communities since. It also supported Senior College at Southwest Minnesota State University in Marshall, Let's Go Fishing of Minnesota and more recently, SWIF's Encore Entrepreneurship program and the Honor Flight Southwest Minnesota organization.

But Schwan's relationship with SWIF goes far beyond the Paul and Alma Schwan Aging Trust Fund. The company has provided tremendous support to SWIF's General Endowment, another permanent resource for southwest Minnesota. By providing the lead gift to SWIF's Growing Home Circle created in 2004 and annual membership to the campaign since—including a \$25,000 gift during SWIF's 25th anniversary year—The Schwan Food Company has helped SWIF meet match opportunities from The McKnight Foundation and leverage important dollars for the region.

Additional gifts have supported SWIF's Student Enrichment Fund, Technology and Telecommunications Initiative (TNT) and the Early Childhood Initiative.

And, when local leaders partnered with SWIF to create the Marshall Community Foundation and Balaton Area Community Foundation, The Schwan Food Company matched gifts to each endowment to support the communities where their employees reside. In addition, they provide marketing support to the foundations and offer time off for employees to serve on their advisory boards.

"It's gone beyond just money," said Theresa Zaske, Community Relations Specialist at The Schwan Food Company. As a resident of Balaton, she has both a company and community volunteer perspective of this unique corporate giving relationship.

"Marvin Schwan started this really great thing but it's continued long beyond his passing." Theresa said.

The impact of The Schwan Food Company's leadership and commitment to giving will be felt for a very long time as well.



The Juul family's story starts out sounding like others shared by families across southwest Minnesota. After serving in the Navy during WWII, Harold came back to his hometown of Hutchinson. In 1947, he married Edith, a farm girl from Nebraska, and a few years later they had two daughters.

Harold and his father owned a successful contracting business and earned a reputation throughout Minnesota for quality workmanship. Harold even mentored young high school and college men who wanted to learn the trade, which his family thought was at least partly due to living with a houseful of girls.

His sense of vision combined with genuine care showed through Harold's many other volunteer roles as well. He served on the telephone company and hospital boards, his church's long-range planning committee and volunteer groups, and was a volunteer counselor for an online counseling service. He loved being in on the cutting edges of technology and enjoyed what was going on around him. His community contributions led to being named "Mr. Hutchinson" in 1985.

He also remained active with his alma mater, Dunwoody College of Technology based in Minneapolis. Harold received the Dunwoody Alumni Achievement Award, was the first donor to establish a charitable gift annuity at Dunwoody and created a scholarship fund to support Dunwoody students.

But his generosity didn't stop there.

Harold was inspired by his wife and daughter, Ellen, to start a nursing scholarship fund. Both women were nurses and he especially wanted to create a resource that could help others further their careers and their lives.

Ellen remembers her father asking what she thought of the idea. He thought it could be a way to help people locally. He also wanted the fund to be endowed, ensuring it would last long into the future.

"Dad had just a heart for people," Ellen said. "He was a great listener."

In 2001, he created the People Helping People Nursing Scholarship Endowment Fund through the Southwest Initiative Foundation's (SWIF) designated fund program, which administers more than 75 funds that benefit a variety of causes throughout the region.

Since then, scholarship grants totaling \$12,000 have been awarded to students. Applications are open to all nursing assistants in McLeod and Meeker counties and the requirements are simple, a reflection of Harold's desire to keep scholarships very accessible to students.

Harold really liked the nursing program at Ridgewater College, which allowed students to continue working while taking courses. It also offered the flexibility needed for non-traditional students to enter and continue in the field, from LPN to RN. Partnering with the College was a natural fit to identify students in need of assistance.

"He cared for people, he was a man of faith, he was a good dad and a good friend to everybody," Ellen said. "Through my dad, and now through his legacy, we're helping people in the area find a way to reach up—to do better in life."

As a full-fledged community foundation, SWIF has the tools and expertise to assist people like Harold Juulpictured above with wife Edith and left with 2003 scholarship recipient Sarah Weseman–establish a named fund that supports their passion.

- **Landowners** receive a tax deduction for the charitable portion of the gift; bypass all capital gains taxes; create stable revenue source for remainder of lifetime; and benefit favorite charities.
- Tenants continue renting the land and keep wealth generated by the land local.
- County maintains tax base, as SWIF continues paying property taxes on the land.
- **Southwest Initiative Foundation** retains ownership of the land and diversifies its investment portfolio; earns revenue from the rent for the benefit of the southwest Minnesota region and its communities; and serves donors in a meaningful way, helping landowners create a legacy.
