Abuse Neglect Dysfunction

56 students out of 81 scored 4 or more. 69%

27 students out of 81 scored 7 or more. 33%

17 students out of 81 scored 8 or more. 21%

ACES Abuse Neglect Dysfunction

#1 issue at 67%:

• Have you lived with anyone with alcohol or drug use problems?

#2 issues at 64%:

Have you often been insulted put down or made fun of by a parent or other adult in your household?

 Have you felt like others in your family didn't love you, didn't feel like you are important or special or didn't look out for or support each other.



Total of students serviced:


2014: **125** Students (**12.5%** of HHS Population)
